*Highlights*

**1. CADBORO BAY VILLAGE**

Cadboro Bay was called Sungayka, meaning “patches of snow.” A village existed here in Loon Bay for at least parts of the last 1500 years. Qoqwialls, a game similar to lacrosse, was played on its shores, and berries were picked nearby. Today, its a thriving metropolis complete with shops, restaurants, and leisure areas.

**2. MYSTIC VALE**

Mystic Vale is a forested ravine that was acquired by the University 1993. Its tree canopy is dominated by large specimens of Douglas-fir. Additionally, Mystic Vale proves to be one of the most popular green spaces on campus as thousands of students and community members use the area every year. Several ecoaction groups and sustainability projects have been implemented to preserve the conditions of the ravine, including creating detention ponds to minimize stream bank erosion and removing invasive species like ivy, daphne and holly.

**3. FINNERTY GARDENS**

The garden contains over 4,000 different trees and shrubs with more than 1,500 rhododendron and azalea plants, including 200 collected rhododendron species, and a spectacular range of companion plants artistically displayed on a 2.6 hectare (6.5 acre) site at the southwest corner of UVic’s campus.

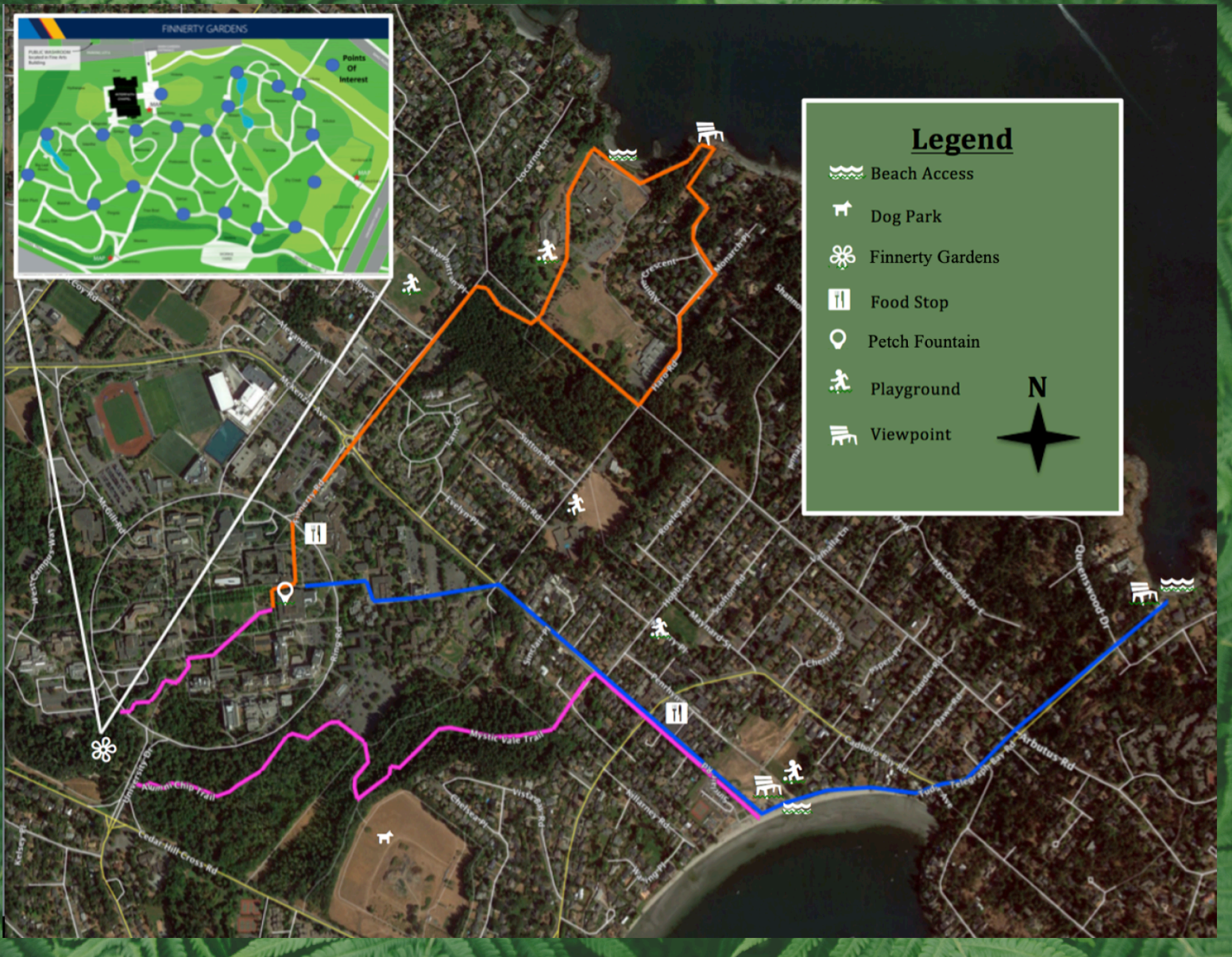
